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The so-called PechaKucha sessions offer researchers the chance to present innovative research ideas to a broad audience. The ultimate aim of these sessions is to find scholars interested in the ideas and to establish new contacts for (international) research collaboration.



### **\*But what is a PechaKucha?\***

PechaKucha 20x20 is a simple presentation format where you show 20 images, each for 20 seconds. The images advance automatically and you talk along to the images. They could involve new research ideas, creative project proposals, etc.

In a PechaKucha session, each presenter has 10 minutes for his/her PechaKucha. In a 90-minute session slot, up to six presenters give their PechaKucha presentation, followed by 30 minutes informal networking opportunities (e.g. discussing ideas, exchanging information, establishing new contacts).

In the PechaKucha, please include:

- A concrete statement / image what you desire to discuss with other scholars in the session
- Implement the 20-second rule in the presentation (e.g. in Powerpoint)
